## **I. OVERVIEW**

The Cherbourg SIVEP (Department of veterinary and phytosanitary border control) comprises:

- the Cherbourg Border Control Post (BCP), as accredited by European Commission Decision C (2019) 2900 (final) of 11 April 2019. It is responsible for the import control of the following live animals and animal products:

HC: products intended for human consumption (frozen, chilled or without temperature conditions)

NHC: products not intended for human consumption (frozen, chilled or without temperature conditions)

U: ungulates of the equidae family only

E: registered equidae within the meaning of Directive 90/426/EEC

O: other live animals (including zoo animals)

- The Designated Point of Entry (DPE) of Cherbourg is responsible for the import control of animal feed of non-animal origin.
- The Community Point of Entry (CPE) of Cherbourg is responsible for the phytosanitary import control of plants and plant products.

## **II. SIVEP CHARGES**

The SIVEP applies the following charges (on top of the fee for the veterinary and phytosanitary import controls as stipulated in the decree of 25 June 2012).

### **ALL PRICES ARE IN EURO AND SUBJECT TO VAT**

Daily charges apply per 24-hour day, from midnight to midnight, or part thereof, unless otherwise stated.

Weekday/Saturday hours (WS) apply from 06:00 to 21:59, from Monday to Saturday, except for public holidays.

Night/Sunday/Public Holiday hours (NSPH) apply at all other times.

Hourly charges apply per hour or part thereof.
